- The BAPTIST COACH ACCREDITATION TRAINING!

BAPTIST COACH ACCREDITATION TRAINING is bringing to reality a new vision focusing on empowering and developing our current and future leaders.

THE COACH ACCREDITATION TRAINING's vision is that by 2014/2015 a coaching movement will have been raised up among NSW Baptists that allows every church planter to be coached, and provides the opportunity for every Baptist pastor who wants a coach, to have one.



- Upon successful completion of the accreditation training, participants will be certified as accredited coaches with the BAPTIST UNION OF NSW.
- Accreditation is maintained with participation in ongoing training, at least once per year.

Level 1 Coach Training

Participants in the Level 1 Coaching program must have completed, as a pre-requisite, the BUNSW one day Foundations Seminar.

The Level 1 training will take place over a 6 month period and involve:

1. An initial 1 day intensive which will include a personality profiling seminar.
2. The participant will be required to coach at least 2 people (min. 6 sessions each) for the duration of the training period.
3. The participant will be provided with a coach supervisor, with whom they will meet 6 times over the duration of the training period.
4. A 4 Hour Mid-term Intensive
5. A final full day face-to-face seminar.
6. A required reading component for which all reading material will be provided.



The aim of the training is that the participants will then be able to coach others, and that some will also become Coach Supervisors for future participants in the programme.

In entering the training, participants agree not to charge for their coaching until they are accredited, and thereafter charge at the agreed rate for coaching under the Union's COACH ACCREDITATION PROGRAMME (currently \$75/session).

Who is coordinating this programme?

THE COACHING STEERING COMMITTEE, consisting of Pete Davies, Grant Morrison and Rob Feeny are the driving body.

The Committee is accountable to the EVANGELISM & CHURCH DEVELOPMENT TASKFORCE (ECDT).

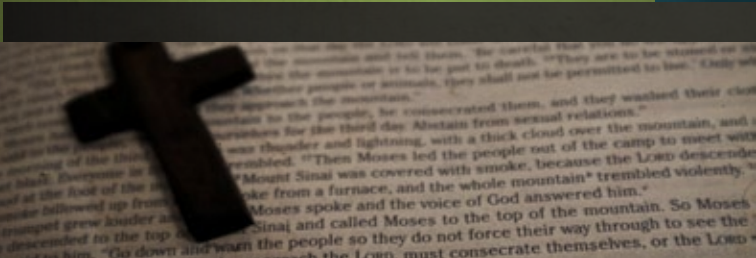
