The Senior Chaplain provides guidance and advice on pastoral, cultural, humanitarian, spiritual and religious matters to senior management, SES chaplains and all SES members. The Senior Chaplain coordinates the deployment of SES Chaplains during operations and in response to the needs of SES members and their families.

SELECTION CRITERIA: The Senior Chaplain must be an ordained or licensed Minister of an established denominational/faith group and be in good standing with their respective church body. Have experience in chaplaincy; be willing to work in an ecumenical/inter-faith environment that provides pastoral and spiritual support to all, irrespective of religious background. Have the ability to relate sensitively to a diverse group of staff and volunteers at all levels of the organisation and maintain positive pastoral relationships. Be familiar with and sympathetic to the principles and practices of Critical Incident Stress Management. Be willing to work out of hours when operational activities require it as well as participating in after-hours on-call rosters. Be available to travel within NSW and inter-state as required.

JOB NOTES: Out of hours operational activities will be required from time to time. Relevant criminal history, referee reports and prior employment checks will be conducted on the recommended applicant. Participation in after hour's on-call rosters and out of ordinary hours work (including at weekends) and travel within NSW and inter-state is required in this position.
