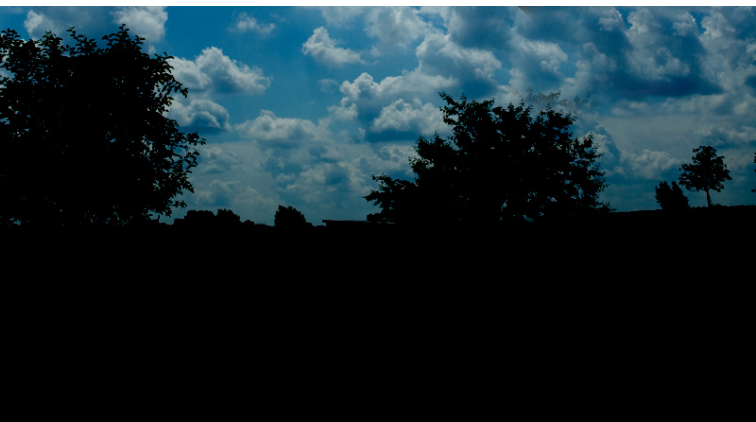
This stand-alone seminar explores the foundations for healthy coaching and mentoring, the unique features of each, and introduces the basic skills and resources in the GROW coaching model.
